How to enter:

- 1. Send in your name, contact details and dates available (you must be available for 4 nights in a row), along with any food preferences or allergies
- 2. Names will then be drawn and the foodies will be contacted
- 3. Pay the AED 250 entrance fee which will go towards the charity of that week.

- 5. Each night, contestants will rate the hosts and send their scores in out of 10 by email, along with any constructive comments
