However, little does he know that his new life of awesomeness is about to be threatened by the emergence of a formidable villain, one who plans to use a secret, unstoppable weapon to conquer China and destroy kung fu for good.

It shouldn't be a surprise after the first one, but Dreamworks' latest cartoon sequel remains a

genuinely good martial arts movie, with some of the year's best fight sequences and inarguably the best use of 3-D in a long time.

The film also marks an impressive directing debut by artist-animator Jennifer Yuh - hardly a scene goes by that isn't visually striking or kinetically thrilling.

Jack Black is back on top form as the voice of Po and sounds likes he's having a ball in the studio. In fact, the casting in general is inspired and the eclectic voices are all a perfect fit for their animal counterparts.

Bigger and better than the original, Kung Fu Panda 2 skilfully avoids the curse of the sequel with wit, flair and a 3D paw to the face.
